be pleased to state:

(a) the details of total kilometers of National Highways (NHs) constructed in Uttar Pradesh (UP) during the last two years and the amount spent thereon;

(b) the roads identified in UP for development as National Highways;

(c) the name of the NHs carpeted during the said period in the State; and

(d) whether the road from the highway to the village Rawal (U.P.) has been constructed, if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor along with the time by which it is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) During the last two years (2014-15 and 2015-16), 980 kilometers length of National Highways (NHs) have been constructed with an expenditure of Rs. 1144.70 crore. However, this does not include the expenditure incurred on construction of projects executed on the Build Operate Transfer (BOT) mode.

(b) During the said period, Ministry has declared 5 numbers State roads as new National Highways and 36 numbers of State roads as "In-Principle" declared National Highways in the State of Uttar Pradesh as per the details at Annexure.

(c) During the said period, 1870 km length on the NHs No. 7, 11, 19, 24, 25, 28B, 28 C, 29, 29E, 56, 58, 58E, 72A, 73, 74, 75E, 76, 76E, 86, 91A, 93, 96, 97, 119, 232, 233, 235, 330A, 730 and 931 was carpeted under the maintenance and repair of National Highways.

(d) This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development and maintenance of National Highways network in the country and the village road from NH to Rawal (U.P.) village is not a part of National Highways network and hence does not come under the purview of this Ministry.
