(c): Presently two Brownfield airports at Delhi and Mumbai and three Greenfield airports at Hyderabad, Bangalore and Cochin are operational under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode.
(d): Yes Madam. With the implementation of Public Private Partnership projects at both Brownfield and Greenfield airports, the infrastructure and service delivery at Indian airports has improved at par with international standards. The PPP airports consistently feature in the top ranks in the global ranking published by the Airport Council International.
