However some of the projects are delayed mainly due to land aquisition, utility shifting, non availability of Soil/Aggregates, Poor performance of contractors, Environment/Forest/Wildlife Clearance, ROB & RUB issue with Railways, Public agitation for additional facilities, Arbitration/contractual disputes with contractors etc.
