WATER SUPPLY SCHEMES/PROPOSALS

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether certain States including Karnataka and Gujarat have submitted any water supply schemes/proposals relating to their water scarce areas to the Government during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the areas covered thereunder, State-wise along with the action taken thereon;
- (c) whether Gujarat has requested for viability gap funding/financial support to meet the capital cost of 4 desalination plants costing Rs.3500 crores approximately; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the action taken in the matter so far?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT & GANGA REJUVENATION
(DR. SANJEEV KUMAR BALYAN)

(a) to (d) Government of Gujarat submitted a project proposal for Rs.4570 crore to Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation for funding as “Special Case” under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP). Government of Gujarat has not requested for viability gap funding, but the proposal submitted includes the completion of desalination plants at two strategic locations (Devbhoomi, Dwarka and Somnath District) in Saurashtra costing Rs.400 crore. In view of the limited allocation of Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation under NRDWP in 2016-17 and there being no provision for funding as a special case under NRDWP guidelines, the proposal was not approved. The State Government has been requested to make a project proposal / DPR pertaining to rural habitation facing drinking water supply problems.

In addition, the Government of Gujarat submitted a proposal for renovation of 67 water bodies costing Rs.132.08 crore for restoration of an irrigation potential of 12331 hectares. The proposal could not be processed further as the State Government has not submitted the compliance of CWC comments.

Government of Karnataka submitted three proposals consisting of renovation of 133 water bodies costing Rs.84.11 crore for restoration of 5797.28 hectare irrigation potential. The State Government has not submitted the compliance of CWC comments.

Further, out of the states with Desert Development Programme (DDP) block areas, Government of Andhra Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh & Gujarat have submitted project proposals to Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation for funding from various external agencies. The details of the project proposals and the action taken are at **ANNEXURE I**.
