**RESERVATION TO IAS OFFICERS**

Äl 60. SHRI HARISHCHANDRA CHAVAN:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether reservation is applicable to the IAS officers belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of persons of the aforesaid category who were promoted during the last three years, alongwith the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (d) the number of complaints received in this regard during the above period?

**ANSWER**

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (d): As per the policy of the Government, the percentage of reservation for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes is 15% and 7.5% respectively in respect of Direct Recruitment to Indian Administrative Service (IAS). There is no reservation in promotion subsequent to their appointment to IAS.
