Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and the total number of Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) dispensaries in the country, State/ UT-wise;
- (b) whether there have been demands from various quarters including CGHS beneficiaries to cover all the State Capitals and major cities under the CGHS, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise and the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to expand the coverage of CGHS by including private hospitals therein and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the action taken/being taken by the Government in this regard along with the time by which more cities are likely to be covered under the CGHS?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

- (a): Details of the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Wellness Centres in the country is at Annexure-I
- (b) to (d): Some representations have been received from various quarters like Pensioner Associations, Central Government Employees Welfare Coordination Committees and VIPs etc. for expansion of CGHS.

Orders have been issued for opening of CGHS Wellness Centre in the following cities:

Raipur, Itanagar, Agartala, Imphal, Aizwal, Kohima, Panaji, Gangtok and Vishakhapatnam

These wellness centres will be operationalised on the availability of the suitable accommodation.

CGHS also empanels private hospitals in the cities where CGHS is in operation to cater to the indoor treatment needs of CGHS beneficiaries. Details of hospital empanelled under CGHS are at Annexure-II.
