(a) to (c): Yes, Madam, in the officers grade 184 direct recruitment posts and 97 promotional posts are vacant and action for their filling up has been initiated through Union Public Service Commission for direct recruitment posts and through Departmental Promotion Committees for promotional posts. Further, in subordinate grades 3373 direct recruitment posts are vacant, out of which against 962 vacancies, demand has been submitted to Staff Selection Commission and against 2176 vacancies, recruitment process has been initiated departmentally. 235 more direct recruitment vacancies in subordinate grades have recently occurred after approval of cadre review by the Government.
