(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The Cabinet in its meeting held on 7th October 2015 has approved the proposal for construction of National War Memorial at 'C' Hexagon of India Gate and the National War Museum at Princess Park Complex in Delhi. A dedicated Project Management Team has been constituted for planning and executing the project from conception till completion working under the guidance / directions of Empowered Apex Steering Committee chaired by Defence Secretary. The tentative timeframe for project completion is five years.

(c) The approximate cost of the project at current price level is Rs.500 Crores.
