SHORTAGE OF MEDICAL FACILITIES AT PGIMER

1709. SHRI RAVNEET SINGH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a severe shortage of medical facilities in Civil Hospital at Ludhiana leading to a lot of pressure on the PGIMER, Chandigarh;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to upgrade the Civil Hospital to 1000 bedded Multispeciality hospital;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

- (a): As per information from the State Government of Punjab, adequate facilities are available at the Civil Hospital Ludhiana.
- (c) & (d): Public health & hospitals is a State subject. As per the information received from the State Government of Punjab, presently there is no proposal for up-gradation of Civil Hospital to 1000 bedded multi-speciality hospital. They will upgrade the hospital whenever they find it appropriate to do so.
