(a) whether there is no Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) empanelled hospital in suburban Mumbai for Cancer and other life threatening diseases;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor;

(c) whether some of the CGHS empanelled hospitals in Mumbai have withdrawn cashless facilities to the pensioners; and

(d) if so, the reasons therefor and necessary steps taken in this regard?

(a) & (b): There are two CGHS empanelled hospitals in western suburban Mumbai for cancer and other life threatening diseases;
