INJECTABLE CONTRACEPTIVES

1786. SHRI DHARAM VIRA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to make Injectable Contraceptives available to the public, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the details of current budgetary allocation to ensure sustained attention to quality of contraceptive care?

- (a): Yes. The Government proposes to make Injectable Contraceptives available to the public.

It has been decided to introduce it in a phased manner starting from Medical Colleges, District Hospitals followed by Sub district hospitals, CHCs and subsequently to PHCs and SCs.

- (b): The current budgetary allocation to ensure sustained attention to quality of contraceptive care is Rs. 77665.45 lakhs.
