- (a) whether the syllabus of Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (BAMS) Course has lesser Ayurvedic Science in comparison with the syllabus of Modern Medical Sciences, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Ayurveda Medicine Manufacturers Organisation of India (AMMOI) has taken up the matter with the Government for making a comprehensive Ayurvedic Syllabus in the course, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the response of the Government in this regard?
