- (a) the total number of private Engineering colleges, State-wise and the number of total seats available and seats which remain vacant in these colleges during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether these colleges are meeting the criteria fixed by All India Council of Technical Education/University Grants Commission regarding infrastructure, equipment and qualified faculty;
- (c) if so, the employability rate of students passing out of these colleges; and
- (d) whether there is any provision to limit the number of seats/colleges in each State so that mushrooming of colleges/ institutions can be checked and quality education is provided to students thereby increasing their employability and if so, the details thereof?
