ASSISTANCE FOR DEVELOPMENTAL PROJECTS

No. 188. SHRI UDAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has allocated any funds for implementation of various projects relating to development works in the National Capital Delhi; and
- (b) if so, the details of various development projects being implemented in Delhi with central assistance?

(a)& (b):The Ministry of Urban Development has allocated funds for implementation of the following developmental projects/Missions being implemented in Delhi with Central Assistance:

(i) Smart Cities Mission

New Delhi Municipal Council has been selected for Development as Smart City. An amount of Rs 196 crore has been released to the National Capital Territory of Delhi for the purpose.

(ii) Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation(AMRUT)

The State Annual Action Plan of Delhi for 2015-16 with project cost of Rs 223.07 crore has been approved. Sectoral investment approved is as below:

The Union Territory of Delhi has been indicated Central Assistance of Rs 804.18 crore during the entire Mission period.

(iv) Delhi Metro Rail Project

The project is being implemented as a 50:50 joint venture of the Government of India and the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi. The Government has allocated Rs 7079.41crore for the purpose during 2016-17.

(v) Funding under National Capital Region Planning Board(NCRPB) and the Urban Development Fund

A total of Rs 643.58 crore has been sanctioned from Urban Development Fund for 5 projects aimed at decongesting Delhi. The NCRPB has sanctioned financial assistance of Rs. 386.24 crores and released Rs. 330 crores for three infrastructure projects in Delhi.
