- (a) The total number of scholarships granted under different scholarship schemes of the Ministry of Human Resource Development during last three years from 2013-14 to 2015-16 and current year 2016-17 are as follows:

(b) To bring awareness about the Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students, the State Education Boards bring out advertisement in the regional dailies and also the information about the scheme is uploaded on their portal. For bringing awareness about the Special Scholarship Scheme for Jammu & Kashmir, workshops are organised for the target group in the districts of the Jammu & Kashmir and also public notice is brought out in the regional dailies. The Department of School Education & Literacy had requested all State /UT Governments to take necessary initiatives to popularize the scholarship schemes among targeted groups and schools so that students can avail the benefit.
