(a) to (c): The draft Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) Bill intends to grant statutory status to the 20 existing Indian Institutes of Management to enable them to grant degrees to their students in the academic courses conducted by these institutes. The Bill intends to ensure greater synergy and functional autonomy to these institutes. The Bill is under formulation in consultation with various Ministries and stakeholders.
