(a) and (b) The issue of creation of new zones and divisions has been examined and studied by various Committees including Railway Reforms Committee (RRC), keeping in view various aspects of railway working. The issue has also been examined by a Senior Administrative Grade level Officers' Committee set up in 2012.

(c) to (e): Receipt of proposals from various State Governments, Members of Parliament, other elected representatives for creation of new divisional offices is a continuous process. These proposals are examined from the standpoint of administrative and operational requirement.
