SETTING UP OF MSME

1966. SHRI G.M. SIDDESHWARA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plan to set up more Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) units in the country particularly in the backward and tribal areas in the country including Karnataka;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, location-wise and State-wise/UT-wise; and
- (c) the amount of funds allocated for this purpose during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a)&(b): No, Madam. Setting up of an enterprise is an individual's endeavour. However, Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises has been implementing various schemes and programmes for promotion of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSMEs) at all India level including in the backward and tribal areas in the country and Karnataka. The major schemes/programmes include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme, Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS), National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme, Cluster Development Programme, Marketing Development Assistance and Skill Development Programmes, etc.
- (c): The funds are not allocated State-wise as all the plan schemes implemented by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) are Central Sector Schemes. The total outlay (BE) allocated to Ministry of MSME for promotion of MSMEs sector during the last three years and the current year i.e. 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 is Rs.2977.00 crore, Rs.3327.00 crore, Rs.2612.51 crore and Rs.3000.00 crore, respectively.
