- (b) Archaeological Survey of India has established a new Circle in Andhra Pradesh, viz., Amravathi Circle; by bifurcation of its Hyderabad Circle vide Notification dated 08.06.2016. Both the Circles i.e., Amaravathi, Andhra Pradesh and Hyderabad, Telangana shall function from the existing premises at Hyderabad until the capital of Andhra Pradesh is shifted to Amaravathi.
