PROMOTION OF MSME EXPORT

1981. SHRI C.S.PUTTA RAJU:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has initiated a plan of action to extend requisite support to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) to make their exports more competitive, as very small percentage of MSMEs are currently exporting;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the extent to which the Government has achieved success in this regard so far?

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises has been implementing various schemes and programmes for promotion of micro, small and medium enterprises for making their exports more competitive. Some of the major schemes/programmes include Market Development Assistance; International Co-operation Scheme; Training Programmes on Packaging for Exports; National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme (NMCP); Cluster Development Programme; Credit Guarantee Scheme; Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme; etc.

(c): For implementing various schemes for the development of MSMEs, the Ministry has allocated Rs. 2,835.00 Crore, Rs. 2,977.00 Crore, Rs. 3,327.00 Crore, Rs. 2,612.51 Crore and Rs. 3,000.00 Crore for 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 respectively. The physical achievement of the major schemes for the last two years is annexed.
