(b) & (c) : Since 2015 – 2016, the Ministry of Human Resource Development has started joint counseling from the point of view of minimization of vacant seats. The joint counseling brought Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), National Institutes of Technology (NITs), Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs), Indian School of Mines (ISM), Dhanbad and other Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) under one umbrella. The objective of common counseling is to eradicate / remove the problem of reserving the multiple seats. Multiple options can be applied for by the candidates but not more than one seat can be reserved.
