Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Delhi Police is conducting a SMART (Sensitive and Strict, Modern and Mobility, Alert and Accountable, Reliable and Responsive, Trained and Techno-Savvy) online test for 30,000 police personnel currently employed in 183 police stations;
- (b) if so, the details regarding the process of test system, the agency preparing, evaluating and monitoring the test along with the broad parameters on which this test has been devised; and
- (c) the details of plans, if any, on such service test being conducted through the personnel department for civil security forces?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Delhi Police has reported that a test module is being developed by them and an online test is proposed to be conducted which is at trial stage. The question bank and application will be hosted in the Data Centre at SCRB (State Crime Record Bureau) of Delhi Police. The

question papers for the proposed Online Test were prepared by serving officers. The objective is to have an online platform where professional knowledge of personnel can be tested and which will also provide impetus for skill upgradation. The proposed Online Test is in a format of multiple choice options and the evaluation is also computerized. The tests are proposed to be conducted at the various Computer Centers at District/Unit level. The test is to give domain knowledge to officers and is not linked to any pecuniary or other service benefit.
