- (a) whether the Union Government has received a representation from the State Government of Maharashtra relating to Vidarbha Intensive Irrigation Development Programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. Vidarbha Intensive Irrigation Development Programme was being implemented as a sub-scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) from 2012-13. During the current year, funds have been earmarked for other sub-schemes against the slot of sub schemes of RKVY which is 20% of the RKVY allocation. The projects for implementation under RKVY are approved and implemented by the concerned state governments as per their needs and priorities from funds allocated to them. An amount of Rs.396.29 crore has been allocated to the State Government of Maharashtra under RKVY during 2016-17 of which Rs.200.24 crore has been released till date.
