1.	AIIMS	The Cabinet has approved the setting up of AIIMS at Mangalagiri in Andhra Pradesh with a total cost of Rs. 1618 crore in October 2015. MoU has been signed with the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh and taking over of land at Andhra Pradesh has been done. Pre-investment activities of soil survey, topographical survery etc has been completed at the site.
2.	IIT	IIT Tirupati is established in the State of Andhra Pradesh and the academic session has been commenced from the academic year 2015-16. An amount of Rs. 28 crore has been released to the Institute.
3.	IISER	The academic session in the institute has commenced from Aug 2015 from its transit campus at Tirupati. An amount of Rs. 23 crore was released during 2015-16.
4.	Agriculture University	Rs. 122.5 crore has been released for the establishment of the new Agriculture University in the State of Andhra Pradesh.
5.	Tribal University	Site has been finalized in Vizianagaram district in Andhra Pradesh for setting up of a Tribal University.
