- (a) whether the Government is aware that lack of coordination between the forensic department and Police is causing delay in criminal judicial system in the country; and
- (b) if so, the action taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): No, Madam. Home Department in the States oversee the coordination between the Police and Forensic Department/Laboratories.

The seven Central Forensic Science Laboratories also coordinate with various State Police Organisations as required.
