STRENGTH OF SC/ST EMPLOYEES

2309. SHRI NANDI YELLAIAH:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state the strength of Scheduled Caste employees as per their main caste and sub-castes working under Central Government, State-wise and Union Territory-wise for 2014-2015 and 2015-2016?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

The benefit of reservation for the Central Government posts and services is provided to the Scheduled Castes as a composite group and not caste/sub caste-wise. Recruitment and filling up of vacancies in Central Government Departments/ Ministries is done by respective Cadre Controlling Authorities in centralized manner and not State-wise. As per information received from 71 Ministries/Departments, there were 5,18,919 Scheduled Castes employees in the Central Government Departments/ Ministries, as on 01.01.2014 and 5,56,850 Scheduled Caste Employees as on 01.01.2015 as per information received from 59 Ministries/Departments.
