Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state the strength of Scheduled Caste employees as per their main caste and sub-castes working under Central Government, Statewise and Union Territory-wise for 2014-2015 and 2015-2016?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister & Office. (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

The benefit of reservation for the Central Government posts and services is provided to the Scheduled Castes as a composite group and not caste/sub caste-wise. Recruitment and filling up of vacancies in Central Government Departments/ Ministries is done by respective Cadre Controlling Authorities in centralized manner and not State-wise. As per information received from 71 Ministries/Departments, there were 5,18,919 Scheduled Castes employees in the Central Government Departments/ Ministries, as on 01.01.2014 and 5,56,850 Scheduled Caste Employees as on 01.01.2015 as per information received from 59 Ministries/Departments.
