IMPACT OF INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS ON LAND PRICES

No. 2350 SHRI ASADUDDIN OWAISI:

Will the Minister OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Government has appointed a committee including representation of all the infrastructure ministries to assess the impact of infrastructure projects on the prices of land;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the said committee has suggested imposing impact fee on land owners whose prices have gone up due to infrastructure development;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has considered the report of the committee; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the time by which a final decision is likely to be taken in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAIAH NAIDU)

- (a) to (b): No, Madam. No such committee has been appointed in the Ministry of Urban Development. The Government has however set up an Inter-Departmental Committee to formulate a National Value Capture Policy.
- (c) to (f): The Committee is yet to submit its final report.
