- (c) & (d) All India Radio already has language services in Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam as part of the bouquet of services offered to Indian diaspora in South Asia, Mauritius, East Africa, West Asia etc. That is apart from huge network of stations of AIR in all South Indian states serving the people as per their mother tongue, their culture, heritage etc.
