BSNL SERVICE IN RURAL AREAS

2371. SHRI R. GOPALAKRISHNAN:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of villages provided with telecom facilities separately for the mobile and landline services by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), State-wise;
- (b) whether BSNL plans to provide all the village panchayats with telecom facility and proposes to install mobile towers in each village panchayat and also provide 3G service in the villages;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the details of 2G and 3G mobile towers set up in the villages so far, State-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has taken steps to ensure and improve the quality of services provided by the BSNL in rural areas, especially the issues of call drops, mobile connectivity etc.; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS & MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MANOJ SINHA)

- (a) The details of total number of villages covered by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) with mobile services and Village Panchayat Telephone (VPT) facility in the country is at **Annexure-I** and **Annexure-II** respectively.
- (b)&(c) State-wise details of village panchayats covered with telecom facility by BSNL is at **Annexure-II.** State-wise details of 2G Mobile towers set up by BSNL in the villages is given at **Annexure-III.** BSNL has informed that presently 3G BTSs (Base Transceiver Station) are not installed in rural areas, and mobile coverage is provided based on techno-commercial feasibility.
- (d) & (e) BSNL is providing telecom services in its licensed service areas and is meeting benchmarks of most of the QoS(Quality of Service) parameters prescribed by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) in respect of Landline/Broadband service. The call drop rate in BSNL network in its Licensed Service Areas (LSA) in the country including rural segment is within the TRAI benchmark, details of call drop rate is enclosed at **Annexure-IV**. To improve the quality of the services in rural areas, BSNL has taken following steps:-
 - i) A GSM network expansion project has been undertaken to provide connectivity by way of installation of towers and Base Transceiver Stations (BTS) in rural areas throughout the country.
 - ii) The BSNL network is being optimized continuously to improve performance.
