**Open Defecation Free Districts**

**240. SHRI RAJENDRA AGRAWAL:**  
**SHRI VIJAY KUMAR HANSDAK:**

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of districts that have been declared open defecation free throughout the country, State-wise;
- (b) the total number of toilets made under Swachh Bharat Mission in the country by the end of September, 2016;
- (c) the time limit set by the Government to attain complete open defecation in the country;
- (d) the expenditure Government plan to spend to achieve complete sanitation; and
- (e) whether the Government propose to revise the deadlines and targets to make the country open defecation free under the Swachh Bharat Mission and if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

**(SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)**

- (a) State-wise, number of districts that have been declared open defecation free is at Annexure-1.
- (b) Since the launch of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2014, **239.15 lakh** toilets have been constructed under SBM(G) as on **30.09.2016**. In addition to these, **15.30 lakh** toilets have been constructed under MGNREGA since **2.10.2014**.
- (c) Government has set the target to make country open defecation free by 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019.
- (d) Year-wise projected funds requirement under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is as under :-
