REPLACEMENT OF OLD COACHES

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to replace the outdated coaches of Vaishali Superfast Express running between New Delhi and Barauni and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is contemplating to upgrade other facilities including pantry available on this train; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a) No, Madam. The coaches run in 12553/12554 Barauni-New Delhi Vaishali Express are within its codal life.
- (b) Yes, Madam.
- (c) The upgradation of facilities in this and other trains is a continual process, based on policy decisions taken from time to time. With regard to Vaishali Express, the following steps have already been taken:
- Mechanized cleaning of coaches with On-board Housekeeping Service is being ensured.

- 2. Supply of washed linen from mechanized laundry is ensured.
- 3. Proper upkeep and functioning of pantry car equipments is ensured.
- 4. Deficiencies in passenger amenity fittings are rectified during washing pit maintenance.
- 5. Pest and rodent control in the coaches is being done as per schedule.
- 6. Dustbins have been provided in Non-Air Conditioned coaches, in addition to the Air Conditioned coaches.
- 7. Stainless steel mugs with chain arrangement have been provided in the toilets of Non-AC coaches.
