REVAMP OF GOVERNMENT COLONIES

No. 2442                      SHRI SULTAN AHMED:

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT  
be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to revamp certain Government colonies in Delhi allotted to Central Government officials;
- (b) If so, details thereof and the agencies involved in the process;
- (c) the manner in which the proposed project is likely to be financed along with the cost likely to be incurred; and
- (d) the time by which it is likely to be completed?

- (a) to(d): Government has approved on 05.07.2016, the redevelopment of seven General Pool Residential Accommodation (GPRA) colonies viz Sarojini Nagar, Nauroji Nagar and Netaji Nagar by NBCC(India) Ltd., and Kasturba Nagar, Thyagraj Nagar, Srinivaspuri and Mohhamadpur by Central Public Works Department (CPWD) at an estimated cost of Rs.32,835 crore. The project is self- financed through sale of commercial built up area. The target date of completion of the project is five years after handing over hindrance-free land to the implementing agencies.
