2458. SHRI D. S. RATHOD:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds utilized by the Railways for the railway line on Shamlalji Modasa-Kapadvanj-Nadiad route during the year 2015-16;
- (b) whether the Railways has any plan to start a train from Delhi to Mumbai on Shamlalji-Modasa-Kapadvanj-Nadiad route during the 2016-17;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a): On Shamlaji Road- Modasa- Kapadvanj- Nadiad route, only Shamlaji Road- Modasa new line (23 Km) has been taken up as a Material Modification to Ahmedabad-Himmatnagar-Udaipur gauge conversion project. No expenditure has been done on this section in 2015-16 although ₹ 123.60 crore has been spent on 2015-16 on the entire project.
- (b) to (d) No, Madam. At present, there is no proposal to start a new train from Delhi-Mumbai via Shamlaji Road- Modasa-Kapadvanj-Nadiad route. However, introduction of train services is an ongoing process over Indian Railways and is done keeping in view the traffic demand, operational feasibility, resources availability, competing demands, etc.
