- (d) whether the railway is also proposing to open Quick-Service Restaurants (QSR) and Modular Multipurpose Stalls (MMS) at all A1 and A category stations and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) whether any new policy has been introduced by the railways as regards to the stalls at the railway stations and if so, the details thereof?**
