- iii. National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY).

The AMRUT has a reform agenda for urban governance which includes e-governance, augmenting double entry accounting, review of building bye-laws, credit rating of the Urban Local Bodies improvement in levy and collection of user charges etc.
