Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Limited (DMRC) proposes to introduce unattended train operations system during their phase III operation and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether these trains are partially imported with 90% of them manufactured in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether an accident of driverless train has been reported recently and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government has initiated an inquiry in the matter and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the corrective steps taken/being taken by the Government to ensure safety/security of the passengers in driverless trains?
