- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the performance of major ports in the country and if so, the details and the outcome thereof for the last three years and the current year;
- (b) the details of cargo handled during the said period and the targets fixed for the next three years, port-wise;
- (c) whether some of the ports are on the stage of modernization and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the additional capacity added at various ports as a result of the modernization/expansion programme during the said period, port-wise; and
- (e) the details of funds allocated for port development-related schemes during the said period, port-wise?

(a)&(b): Modernization and increasing the capacity of Major Ports is a continuous process. The Ministry is regularly monitoring the Ports projects to modernize/upgrade to increase capacity of the ports and also bring them to the international standards through construction & modernization of berths, installation of state of art equipment & mechanism of cargo handling system at ports including the dredging projects to accommodate large vessels at major ports. With the increasing capacity of Major Ports the traffic will also gradually increase. The details of the performance of Major Ports during last three years and current year are given below:-
