(a)to(d):The details of Government Budgetary Support (GBS) allocated to two Major Ports in Tamil Nadu in the Annual Plans of the Ministry of Shipping during the last three years & current year is given below. Capital Dredging Projects of Chennai and VOC Ports have already been completed. Work orders for Coastal Shipping Berths at Chennai and VOC Ports have been issued and the work is in progress. The position in this regard is regularly monitored at various levels in the Ports as well as in the Ministry so that, the schedule for completion of the works progresses as per the relevant terms and conditions of the work orders.
