Water for Toilets

†2636. **SHRI VIKRAM USENDI:**

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise details of construction of toilets under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin);
- (b) whether sufficient water is being provided for use in the said toilets;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a) As per the information uploaded by the States on the online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) (SBM-G), Individual household latrines (IHHLs) constructed under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), State/UT-wise, from 2.10.2014 to 28-11-2016 is at **Annexure-1**.

(b) and (c) As per National Sample Survey Office Report 2015, **93.9** percentage of households having toilet had access to water for use in toilets.

(d) To ensure adequate availability of water for toilets, under SBM-G, the incentive for individual toilet has been increased from Rs. 10,000 to Rs. 12,000, to provide for water availability, including for storing water for hand-washing and cleaning. The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) and National Rural Drinking Water Programme guidelines also provide for a conjoint approach in the implementation of the programmes of sanitation and water to maximize the availability of water for sanitation purposes.
