NH CONNECTIVITY WITH NON-MAJOR PORTS

2658. SHRI KAPIL MORESHWAR PATIL:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is lack of road connectivity between non-major ports and National Highways, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether proposals have been received from various State Governments including Government of Maharashtra to provide road connectivity between non-major ports and National Highways, if so, the details of such proposals received during 12th Five Year Plan, State-wise;
- (c) the follow-up action taken on the said proposals during the said period, Statewise; and
- (d) the current status of all such road projects?

(a) to (d) The Ministry has taken up detailed review of National Highways (NHs) Network with a view to develop the road connectivity to border areas, development of coastal roads including road connectivity to non-Major ports along with integration with Sagarmala etc., under proposed new programme of 'Bharatmala Pariyojna' in consultation with State Governments. However, these programmes are yet to be formally launched.
