2681. DR. KULAMANI SAMAL:

Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that Paradeep Port in Odisha is lacking infrastructure compared to other Major ports in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes any special initiatives for the development of Paradeep Port;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the details of funds allocated for the purpose during each of the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER

(SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a) Paradip Port Trust is the 2nd largest Major Port of India and has sufficient infrastructure. It is the Major logistic provider for Terminal Power Plants in Southern India and Steel Plants in the hinterland comprising Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Jarsuguda, West Bengal etc.
- (b) Does not arise in view of (a) above.

(c)&(d):Paradip Port Trust is implementing the following capacity augmentation projects on Build Operate Transfer (BOT) basis for its development:-
