be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the International Road Federation (IRF), a Geneva based global body has expressed concern over the collapse of a bridge on the Savitri river on Mumbai-Goa Highway resulting loss of lives, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether IRF has given any suggestion/advice to the State Government/UT agencies including Public Works Department and civic agencies to prevent occurrence of such incidents in future;
- (c) if so, the action taken by the Union Government on the views expressed by the IRF; and
- (d) the strategies formulated to ensure that all the bridges and culverts on road networks are safe?
