- (a) whether the Government has accepted the proposal to provide uninterrupted coal supply the proposed 4000 MW power plant at Pudimadaka in Visakhapatnam district of Andhra Pradesh:
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether his Ministry has approached the Railways for providing train connectivity in order to supply coal to power plant at Pudimadaka; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken by the Government for supply of sufficient coal to the power plant?

(a), (b), (c) & (d): The Government of Andhra Pradesh has requested for grant of coal supply of a higher grade to 4 x 1000 MW Super Critical Thermal Power Project at Pudimadaka in Visakhapatnam district of Andhra Pradesh. The Government of Andhra Pradesh has been informed that allocation of coal blocks/mines are made under the provisions of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Act, 2015 and the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulations) Act, 1957. Accordingly, the Government of Andhra Pradesh was advised to apply for allotment as and when coal mines are offered for allotment through a notice inviting application which are considered as per the extant norms. Coal linkage is considered as per the provisions of the extant linkage policy.

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
