Outlays/Contribution to Hockey India League

2707.SHRI KIRTI AZAD:

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the huge financial outlays/contribution that Government Coal Public Sector Undertaking companies are making to Hockey India League (HIL) run by Hockey India, if so, the details thereof along with the annual sum that Coal India Limited (CIL) is spending to sponsor the Hockey India;
- (b) whether sports policy of the PSUs under the Coal Ministry allow sponsorship money to be spent on conducting private tournaments where foreign players are bought for crores of rupees, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether much of this money raised from PSUs is used to pay fat salaries/fees to officer bearers, officials, lawyers, retainers, consultants etc., if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the commissions are being paid to procure such sponsorship amounts from the Coal industry, if so, the action proposed to be taken by the Government to check the misuse of public money of the PSUs?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF COAL, POWER, NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY AND MINES (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a) & (b) : Coal India Limited (CIL) has informed that in accordance with sports promotion objective of Govt. of India, CIL has adopted a comprehensive sports policy for overall development of sports activities in the company in particular and in the country in general. The sports development activities are carried out from a fund created by contribution from the subsidiaries at the rate of 25 paisa/ton of coal produced in the previous year. One of the objectives of sports policy of CIL is to generate corporate goodwill and brand equity by sponsoring various sports and game events at State, National and International level.

In accordance with the above objective of the sports policy, CIL accepted the proposal to sponsor Hockey India League, 2016 organized by Hockey India as Hockey is a National and popular sport of the country and Hockey India is the National Sports Federation for hockey in India. Further it is recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India to manage Hockey for men and women in India and internationally.

As Hockey India League features the world's best players from across the globe, it provides an opportunity to Indian players to learn and develop from the world's best players. Hockey India League has groomed and developed the young Indian players in their journey from Coal India Hockey League to the Indian team. Coal India sponsored Hockey India League featured 16 Olympians who participated in the 2016 Rio Olympic Games on behalf of India .

Thus, CIL supplemented the country's efforts to assist sportspersons reach higher levels of performance by giving local talent requisite exposure to international standards with ultimate aim of bringing national and international acclaim and glory. CIL has released Rs.1408.07 lakhs for Title Sponsor of Hockey India League 2016 under its sports policy for the year 2016.

All such efforts to support hockey have already started yielding results and India's rankings, both at the Asian and global level, have improved significantly.

(c): CIL has informed that Hockey India comes under the ambit of audit of the CAG. Last CAG's audit was done for years 2009-2013(4 years together) in February / March, 2016.
