- (c) the details of States which will be considered for implementation; and
- (d) the details of categories of consumers which would benefit through this scheme?

(a) to (d): Administration of Electricity tariffs and subsidies is done by the respective States/Power Distribution utilities under regulatory oversight by respective State Regulators.
