1. Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram (RYSK):

The Scheme has following components: -

- i) Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS)

- ii) National Youth Corps (NYC)
- iii) National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development (NPYAD)
- iv) International Cooperation (IC)
- v) Youth Hostel (YH)
- vi) Assistance to Scouting and Guiding Organisations
- vii) National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP)
- viii) National Discipline Scheme Instructors (NDSI)

2. National Service Scheme (NSS)

3. Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD)

Initiatives under above programmes/schemes are designed to enhance information and sensitization of the youth including rural youth and to contribute to their personality development through leadership training. These programmes/schemes are being implemented across the country for encouragement and development of youth as a whole.

(b) & (c): The details of funds allocated and released scheme-wise during the last three years and current year are given in Annexure. The expenditure is incurred all over the country, including in backward states mostly through organizations under the Department, like Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan, National Service Scheme and Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development.
