Stock of Coal

283. SHRI A.ARUNMOZHITHEVAN:

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Coal India Limited's stock now stand at 55.3 million tonnes against 57.7 million tonnes that it opened the year with;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the CIL has been able to liquidate the stock through e-auctions;
- (d) if so, the total quantity of coal liquidated through e-auction during 2015-16; and
- (e) the quantity of coal earmarked for e-auction for the year 2016-17?

**(a)&(b):** As on 01/11/2016, Coal India Limited's stock stands at 39.24 MT against 57.64 MT on 01/04/2016.

**(c)&(d):** CIL was able to liquidate the stock through e-auctions and other commitments. The total quantity of coal dispatched through e-auctions during 2015-16 was 68.45 MT.

**(e):** Under regular E-auction windows viz. Spot & Forward E-auctions, CIL intends to dispatch around 60 MT of coal, which is about 10% of its production in the fiscal year 2016-17.
