HEALTH FACILITIES IN BORDER AREAS

2844. SHRI SHAILESH KUMAR:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has assessed the available health facilities in rural areas along with the Indian border;
- (b) if so, whether the Government is satisfied with the health facilities provided in these areas;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the positive steps proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d): Public health being a State subject, assessment of health facilities is done by States. However, performance of health facilities including those in border and rural areas is monitored through Health Management Information System (HMIS).

As per Rural Health Statistics (RHS) 2014-15, there is a shortfall of 32% Community Health Centres (CHCs), 22% Primary Health Centres (PHCs) and 20% Sub Centres (SCs).

Under the National Health Mission (NHM), support is inter-alia provided for setting up/strengthening of public health facilities in rural areas including border areas.
