3018. SHRI NANDI YELLAIAH:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has been made aware of instances of denial of admission to students for class-XI for science stream, by private and Government schools in various parts of the country including Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the remedial steps taken by the Government in this regard; and
- (d) the details of the criteria to be followed by schools in the country with regard to stream allocation for science/ humanities, etc.?

## **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

(a) to (d): Admissions in Science Stream in Class XI in Private and Government Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) affiliated schools are governed in accordance with Examination Bye-Laws of CBSE. Complaints in this regard against any of its affiliated schools is dealt with as per provisions of Examination Bye-Laws of CBSE. Education being in the concurrent list, majority of the schools including Private Schools and School Education Boards come under Administrative control of respective State Governments and it is for them to determine the criteria to be followed by schools in the country.
